



The Minnis and Cornes Meadow Policy

Swarden Parish Council owns The Minnis and Cornes Meadow on behalf of the parishioners of Swarden for sports and recreational activities.

Commercial use of The Minnis and Cornes Meadow is possible, subject to Parish Council approval. Priority will be given to Swarden residents.

Requests should be:

In writing to the Clerk

Include a full event proposal with timings, what activity is proposed etc Details of relevant insurance and any other regulatory requirements Made at least 2 months prior to the event where possible No plans should be finalised or publicised until the Parish Council has made a decision

The above will enable the Parish Council to complete a risk evaluation and comply with the terms of our insurance policy.

This policy applies to all activity on The Minnis and Cornes Meadow that is of a commercial nature.

In the case of professional dog walkers, dogs in their charge must be on a lead at all times and there is a limit of four dogs at any one time.
