Swarden Parish Council owns The Minnis and Cornes Meadow on behalf of the parishioners of Swarden for sports and recreational activities.

The Parish Council is very supportive of all sporting, fitness and leisure activities. However, of late, the Council is receiving more and more requests from commercial organisations to use our playing fields for their own enterprises. With the betterment of our community in mind, the Parish Council welcomes village community targeted requests but must insist that requests are in writing and include the event proposal, appropriate qualifications and insurance details. Priority will be given to Swarden residents.

This will enable us to complete a risk evaluation and comply with the terms of our insurance policy.

Currently, identified commercial organisations include:

Sporting camps/training

Exercise tuition

Professional dog walking.

Please note that professional dog walkers must keep dogs in their charge on a lead at all times and are limited to four dogs at any one time.
